#### Dear St George's

Since 1838 St George's has been shining the light of Christ in Battery Point. Our tower was built in 1847 and stands as a beacon of hope over Hobart, drawing people to Christ and pointing us to our Father in heaven.

We trace our heritage through the Anglican church all the way back to Jesus' great commission to his apostles to make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything he commanded us.

Our city sees us as the Light on the Hill. What a wonderful picture, drawing on Jesus' words in the Sermon on the Mount "You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden." We can be the light Jesus calls us to be only as we find ourselves in him, the true light of the world. That is who we are.

## Our Context


Battery Point is a **village** in the city. It's a place of **transition.** An **affluent** and **highly educated** suburb with academics, students, public servants, politicians and business people close by.
